Stay 3 feet (1 yard) away from things that are hot.

Boots protect a firefighter's feet from things that are hot or sharp.



A firefighter may use an ax to cut a hole in the roof to let out smoke and heat.



A hose is hooked up to a fire hydrant to get water to put the fire out.
